**2Ch 26:5 AMP** He set himself to seek God in the days of Zechariah, who instructed him in the things of God; and as long as he sought (inquired of, yearned for) the Lord, God made him prosper.

This is another discussion of the benefit of worship. Apparently, even as a teen with great responsibility, Uzziah set himself to seek God and to attend to instruction. And as long as he did so, as long as the worshiper in his heart was in control, God responded—and His reaction was entirely in response to worship.
