It is said of Jesus In Hebrews 5, 'You are forever a priest in the manner of Melchisedec...' The passage goes on to point out the specific aspect in the life of Melchisedec that enabled his prayers to be heard and that would be forever reflected in Jesus own life.'

Heb.5:6 KJV ...Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. 7 Who in the days of his flesh,

when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared.'

Upon first reading, it's Jesus' "strong crying and tears" that jumps off the page at you isn't it? Our natural inclination is to conclude that Jesus prayer was indeed heard **because of His strong crying and tears**. This is NOT what is being said. Although Jesus' praying was doubtlessly fervent and passionate, more importantly He, as with Melchisedec, "was heard **in that He feared**." As we often discuss, this does not mean He was afraid! This "fear" usage is *worshiper-talk*. (NKJV says He "was heard because of His godly fear.")

The point being made by Heb.5:6,7 is that Jesus' prayers were not heard because He's the big boss's son... or due to sympathy for His crying. This
