The Stagger-Factor



Rom 4:18,19 MSG *When everything was hopeless, Abraham believed anyway, deciding to live not on the basis of what he saw he couldn't do but on what God said he would do. And so he was made father of a multitude of peoples. God himself said to him, "You're going to have a big family, Abraham!" Abraham didn't focus on his own impotence and say, "It's hopeless. This hundred-year-old body could never father a child." Nor did he survey Sarah's decades of infertility and give up.*

20,21 AMP *No unbelief or distrust made him waver (doubtingly question) concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong and was empowered by faith as he gave praise and glory to God, fully satisfied and assured that God was able and mighty to keep His word and to do what He had promised.*

Let's offer this simple synopsis of vss. 20,21: **As Abraham glorified God, his faith became fully persuaded.** The key to fully persuaded faith is that vital, intimate, worship connection! Selah.



Additionally...

Vs 20 KJV says, "**Abraham staggered not at the promise**". The greater the challenge, the more unreachable the promise can seem. ...*but was strong in faith, giving glory to God.* (Fully-persuaded faith) **It takes genuine worship to completely remove the "stagger factor"** from any challenge you face.
