Anointed to Fulfill!



You are anointed by God to complete and fulfill the commission He has invested within your heart! It's important to understand that He empowers and protects *purpose*, not just an office or position.

Ps.105:15 quotes 1Chr.16:22, "*Touch not mine anointed...*" This is not referring just to "preachers". God is very protective of His purpose. Note that David's primary mission was not as priest (pastor) or an apostle, etc, but as a king, a musician and a writer. When God calls and appoints to whatever capacity, He equips (empowers) accordingly... then He watches over His word to perform! His required qualifications, however, are indeed unique. Several aspects of this thought are discussed in 1Sam.13.

King Saul, feeling threatened by the gathering of the Philistines, the scattering of his people and the delayed arrival of the prophet Samuel, decides to take matters into his own hands and impatiently approach God as a priest in behalf of the nation. The MSG translation says, "*So Saul took charge.*" This was not just an affront to Samuel's spiritual office, but a threat toward God's greater purpose.

Confronted then by Samuel, Saul naturally justifies his usurped authority. He says that with the threat approaching and no supplication to God being offered, "*I forced myself to*

In Conclusion:

The anointing on David's life was not just because of the office he would hold, it was for the fulfillment of his God-appointed purpose. Furthermore, his qualification was not "ministry gifting" or his "leadership skill-set". The qualification for the anointing (and God's defense and protection thereof) was first, *his worshippers'-heart*. **God sought a man after His own heart to fulfill His purpose.**

(P.S: God's defense doesn't place us in a bubble. It still challenges and requires you and me to "...having done all, stand therefore!" His defense engages most...when I stand!)
